### Any ideas as to why the heels of my feet itch so badly ...

Calluses can definitely contribute to itchy heels. However, in your case it may be something more serious (since you don't report having considerable calluses). The possible explanations include restless leg syndrome, burning leg and foot syndrome, and itch/scratch cycle. These are all forms of peripheral neuropathy.
