In this sample of young adults with low levels of lead exposure, higher blood lead was associated with increased odds of major depression and panic disorder. Exposure to lead at levels generally considered safe could result in adverse mental health outcomes.

Although symptoms of lead poisoning were described more than 1,000 years ago, only in the last 25–30 years has it become widely accepted that lead exposure at levels that do not produce overt symptoms can cause subtle and possibly permanent damage to children’s cognitive functioning.

Environmental lead exposure and children's cognitive function

While the immediate health effect of concern in children is typically neurological, it is important to remember that childhood lead poisoning can lead to health effects later in life, including ADHD, delayed learning, and lower IQ (which will impact school performance), Developmental problems with their offspring.

What Are Possible Health Effects from Lead Exposure?

Neurological symptoms associated with lead overexposure include an impaired ability to coordinate voluntary movements (ataxia), brain damage (encephalopathy), seizures, convulsions, swelling of the optic nerve (papilledema), and/or impaired consciousness.

However, it is more common for lead poisoning to build up slowly over time. This occurs from repeated exposure to small amounts of lead. In this case, there may not be any obvious symptoms. Over time, even low levels of lead exposure can harm a child's mental development. The health problems get worse as the level of lead in the blood gets higher.
